Almost 1500 motions have been considered at IUCN Congresses to date.

With NGOs, governments, and Indigenous peoples' organisations voicing their opinion and voting on motions, the resolutions adopted during Congress shape tomorrow's international biodiversity policies.

International treaties with roots in IUCN Congress decisions include the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands, the UNESCO World Heritage Convention, the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) and the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD).

### IUCN World Conservation Congress 2025

The IUCN Congress 2025 will take place in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates from 9-15 October 2025.

The Abu Dhabi National Exhibition Centre (ADNEC) will host the IUCN Congress 2025. ADNEC offers more than 14,000m² of versatile event space, Exhibition halls, the latest IT solutions and high-speed internet – as well as highly functional onsite catering facilities.

This edition will be the first-ever fully hybrid version of the IUCN Congress, making it possible for online registered participants to access and meaningfully interact at Congress.

Under the theme "Powering transformative conservation", the IUCN Congress 2025 will tackle five critical themes, each driving the bold and transformative change needed to secure a sustainable future for both nature and humanity.

### A Congress in three parts







#### Forum

The Forum is a hub of public debate that includes High-Level Dialogues, training and capacity building sessions, as well as networking, cultural and social events.

#### **Exhibition**

The Exhibition is the most diverse environmental marketplace with 100+ Exhibitors from all over the world. Exhibitors can display their work, impart their knowledge, launch initiatives, host meetings, and more. At pavilions, booths and events held on the four Central Stages.

#### Members' Assembly

At the Members' Assembly, IUCN's 1,400+ government, civil society, and Indigenous peoples' Member organisations vote on pressing conservation and sustainable development actions.

## Booths & pavilions in the Exhibition

Hosting a booth or a pavilion in the Exhibition is the ideal opportunity to showcase your work, network with other participants, present your content and gain visibility.

Booths from  $6m^2$  (and any multiples of  $6m^2$ ) are on offer as well as two fixed sizes of pavilions:  $60m^2$  and  $150m^2$ . Upon request and space allowing, IUCN reserves the right to accommodate a handful of larger pavilions.

The Exhibition Hall is a 14,000m² space, designed to accommodate up to 25 large pavilions and 100 small and medium exhibitor booths as well as food courts, networking areas and four central stages for events. Medium and large pavilion exhibitors will be offered a content slot on one of the Central Stages.

Position of the booths/pavilions will be granted on a first come first served basis, based on the date of signature of the agreement and upon availability of the exhibition floorplan.

Booths are ideal for organisations wanting to present their work and share information on a one-to-one basis with Congress participants. Sessions cannot be run from booths.

Large pavilion holders will be offered one 40min live-streamed session on one of the 4 Central Stages (subject to content being validated by IUCN).
